KUSADASI - DODECANESE - MARMARIS		BODRUM - NORTH DODECANESE - BODRUM	
Day 1	KUSADASI. Boarding starts by 15:30. Overnight stay will be at Kusadasi Harbour.	Day 1	BODRUM. Boarding starts by 15:30 from Bodrum Harbor. You will have free time to visit the town's highlights. Your boat will remain anchored in Bodrum for dinner and overnight stay.
Day 2	SAMOS - PATMOS. In the morning after the customs formalities are completed, we will sail to Samos. Then we will cruise to Patmos. A swimming break and an overnight stay will be made at Patmos Harbour. Here you can take the optional tour to St. John's exile.	Day 2	KOS. After your breakfast you will be informed about the cruise itinerary and boat. When the customs formalities are completed, we will cruise to Kos Island. Dinner and overnight stay will be at Kos harbor. You may join our optional Asclepion & Zia Village tours or you may also explore the city by yourself.
Day 3	LIPSI - LEROS. We will set sail to Lipsi. Swimming break at Lipsi, then we will cruise to Leros. Here we'll have a swimming break and stay at Leros Harbour for overnight.	Day 3	LEROS. We will start to cruise early in the morning to Leros Islands' famous bay Xirokampos for breakfast and lunch. Leros is a mountainous, green island with high cliffs and many small bays and villages. We will anchor in Panteli, located in the East, for the dinner and the overnight.
Day 4	KALYMNOS - PSERIMOS - KOS. Today our first stop will be Kalymnos. Here we will have a swimming break, a visit to the city center. Next stop will be Pserimos. We'll take another swimming break here. Set sail to Kos. We will stay at Kos Harbour for the night.	Day 4	PATMOS. We will cruise to Patmos Island early in the morning. We will have a swimming break in a bay around the island. Patmos is not a big island, but it is one of the best known due to the exile of St. John. You may join an optional St. John Monastery and Apocalypse Cave tour. Dinner and overnight stay will be in Patmos Harbor.
Day 5	GIALI - NISYROS - SYMI. On the way to Nisyros, we will take a swimming break in Giali then set sail to Nisyros. Here in Nisyros there will be an optional Volcano Tour. Then we will set sail to beautiful Symi. Here you can visit the monastery of Panormitis which is an optional tour. There will be a swimming break and then we'll stay in Symi Harbour for the night.	Day 5	LIPSI. We will set sail to Lipsi Island and will have a swimming break in one of the many small islands around it. On Lipsi Island there are beautiful sandy beaches, like Platis and Giolos with their crystal green waters. Dinner and overnight stay will be in Lipsi.
Day 6	RHODES. The cruise destination will be Rhodes. Rhodes is the biggest island of the Dodecanese Islands. Here you may join our optional "Rhodes Old City Tour". Overnight stay will be in Rhodes Harbour.	Day 6	KALYMNOS. We will take a swimming break in a beautiful bay around Kalymnos Island and we are going to enter Pothia, the main harbor. The islanders ensured their livelihood with sponge diving for centuries. There are nice beaches such as Massouri, Mirties and Vlychadia around the island.
Day 7	PARADISE ISLAND - MARMARIS. From Rhodes we will set sail for Marmaris. After the customs formalities are completed in Marmaris, we will have a swimming stop in Paradise Island. Overnight stay will be in Marmaris Harbour. Guests wishing to see more of Marmaris are recommended to go to the city center and experience the lively night life.	Day 7	AKVARYUM - BODRUM. Returning to Turkey, we will have a swimming break at the beautiful waters of Akvaryum (Aquarium) bay where you can see the fish swimming below you. We will be staying at Bodrum Harbor for dinner and our final overnight stay.
Day 8	MARMARIS. The guests will leave the boat with precious memories by 10:30 after breakfast.	Day 8	BODRUM. Disembarkation by 10:30 after breakfast.

Day 1	BODRUM. Boarding starts by 15:30 from Bodrum Harbor. You will have free time to visit the town’s highlights. Your boat will remain anchored in Bodrum for dinner and overnight stay.	Day 1	MARMARIS. Boarding starts by 15:30 from Marmaris Harbour. On the first day, our boat will be anchored in Marmaris Harbour for dinner and an overnight stay. Marmaris, which was built upon the antique Caria city; Physkos has been under the governorship of many different civilizations. The most valuable work of art that you will see today is Marmaris Castle dating from 1577. There is also a mosque and an 8-room caravansaray covered with arches from the Ottoman Period. The ruins of the Antique times lie on Asar Hill; a small hill located on the northern side of the city. Being one of the best-known touristic places of Turkey Marmaris also has a large marina.
Day 2	KOS. After your breakfast you will be informed about the cruise itinerary and boat. When the customs formalities are completed, we will cruise to Kos Island. Dinner and overnight stay will be at Kos Harbor. You may join our optional Asclepion & Zia Village tours or you may also explore the city by yourself.	Day 2	SERCE - BOZUKKALE (LORYMA). After breakfast, you will be informed about the cruise itinerary and then we will set sail for Serçe Bay after the customs formalities are completed. In this beautiful bay you can see the Byzantine shipwreck from the 11th century, which is exhibited in Bodrum Museum. We will anchor at Bozukkale for the an overnight stay. In the ancient city of Bozukkale (Loryma), there is a castle which stretches out in a rectangle with its city walls and 9 towers.
Day 3	GYALI - NISYROS. Early in the morning, we will have a swimming break at a bay of Gyalı Island on the way to Nisyros Island. The volcano on Nisyros erupted in 1422 and is still active. Nikea village, located on the side of the crater is constituted with white streets and a mosaic-style square. You can take an optional bus tour to the crater (volcano). Your boat will stay here for the dinner and the overnight.	Day 3	BOZBURUN - DIRSEBUKU - BENCİK. Early in the morning we start to cruise to Bozburun which is a small fishing town. This area was popular and suitable for sponge-diving but nowadays the people of the island are no longer interested in sponge-diving as it is not financially beneficial and it is dangerous. In the recent years sponge-diving has been replaced by gulet tourism. We will anchor at Dirsek Bükü for lunch and a swimming break. Today, our last stop will be at Bencik Bay; which has a very narrow entrance but a unique view once you get inside. Bencik is located at the narrowest part of the peninsula that divides the Hisarönü Gulf from the Gökova Gulf but it is located on Hisarönü side. For dinner and an overnight stay, we will anchor at Bencik Bay.
Day 4	SYMI. Our next destination is the charming bay of Nanou in Symi Island where the boat will anchor for lunch and a swimming break. We will anchor at Symi Port late in the afternoon. You can see the shoreline with its neo-classical houses and the peripheral districts. You are going to adore Symi Island for its colourful houses and narrow streets with hundreds of stairs.	Day 4	AKTUR - DATÇA. Today our first stop will be Aktur Bay. After lunch and a swimming stop, we will cruise to Datça. Food and water will be supplied for the boat from Datça Harbour. Datça was founded by the Dorians who came from the Aegean Sea to the southern coast of Ionia in the 7th century B.C. The island has no humidity at all and has fresh air with plenty of oxygen. The historian Strabon was right when he remarked of Datça's weather:
Day 5	RHODES. We will cruise to Rhodes early in the morning. The island has a unique historical harmony and beauty. Here you can join our optional old city tour. After dinner, we recommend you to enjoy in Rhodes Town night out.	Day 5	SYMI. After customs formalities are completed, we will set sail to Symi Island and anchor at a near bay to Symi Harbour for lunch and a swimming break. We will anchor at Symi Port early in the evening. You can see the shoreline with its neo-classical houses and the peripheral districts. You are going to adore Symi Island for its pine and oak forests and unique bays. You can hire a vehicle to go to the Monastery of Panormitis located in a well-protected bay at the southern part of Simi.
Day 6	DATÇA - PALAMUTBUKU - KNIDOS. We return to Turkey via Datca customs. While your boat is supplying fresh provisions, you may take a walk in Datca Harbor. After we will cruise to Palamutbuku for lunch, you may also take a walk in the village. Today our final destination will be the world famous ancient city of Knidos. You may visit the open air museum after a swimming break.	Day 6	RHODES. We will cruise to Rhodes early in the morning. Rhodes is the largest of the Dodecanese Islands. The island is quite a popular holiday destination as it has one of the best-preserved and the largest European Medieval cities and has warm weather for 300 days of the year. Rhodes has been the cradle of many civilizations; starting with the knights of St. John in the Middle Ages, then Ottomans and Italians. Thus, the island has a unique historical

			harmony and beauty. After dinner, we highly recommend you to enjoy in Rhodes Town.
Day 7	BLACK ISLAND - POYRAZ HARBOUR - BODRUM. We will begin to cruise early in the morning to Karaada (Black Island). Breakfast and a swimming break will be at Poyraz Bay, a nice bay with its turquoise-blue waters on the northern side of the island. We will dock in Bodrum Harbor for dinner and overnight stay.	Day 7	MARMARIS. Before entering Marmaris Port, we will anchor at Cennet Island (Paradise Island). Lunch time and a swimming break will take place here. Then, we will anchor at Marmaris Harbour for dinner and an overnight stay.
Day 8	BODRUM. Disembarkation by 10:30 after breakfast.	Day 8	MARMARIS. The guests will leave the boat with precious memories by 10:30 after breakfast.
