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| Day 1 | BODRUM. Boarding starts by 15:30 from Bodrum Harbor. You will have free time to visit the town’s highlights. Your boat will remain anchored in Bodrum for dinner and overnight stay. | Day 1 | BODRUM. The boarding starts by 15:30 from Bodrum Harbour. You will have free time to visit the town’s highlights. | Day 2 | ORAK ISLAND - COKERTME. After the breakfast we will cruise to Orak Island. A swimming break is given in the crystal blue waters of Orak Island and after lunch, we will cruise to the bay of Cokertme. Dinner and overnight stay will be nearby this cute fishing village. The passengers who desire can take a short walk on the beach to get some fresh air and to explore the environment. | Day 2 | KNIDOS - MERSINCIK. Early in the morning, we will cruise to Knidos. If the weather conditions permit, we can use the sail on the way. Cnidus was a developed city in science, art and architecture. The island also hosts the largest sun clock of its time which was erected by Eudoksos. Knidos was the home for Aphrodite's monument and in those times the city was famous for brothels and became popular for sailors and Arabic tradesmen. You may also take a walk on the shore to see the ruins. Then we will cruise to Mersincik for dinner and an overnight stay. If the weather conditions permit, we can use the sails on the way. |
| Day 3 | SEVEN ISLANDS (KUFRE / UZUN LIMAN) - AYINDA BAY. Before breakfast in the early morning, we will cruise to Seven Islands. Our first stop in Seven Islands will be Kufre Bay; afterwards we will anchor at Uzun Liman (Long Harbor). We will sail to Ayinda Bay for dinner and overnight stay. | Day 3 | CATI - SEVEN ISLANDS. Early in the morning, we will move to Çatı Bay where you will have your breakfast. It is a pleasant bay which is located at the southern part of the Gulf of Gökova and surrounded by the pine trees. Then we will cruise to Seven Islands for lunch. You will experience another excellent day in the Seven Islands Region. In this region which is full of many small islands and coral reef; it is recommended that you should dive, swim, sleep and rest. Our guests can also enjoy a walk in the forests which are filled with pine trees. Our first stop in Seven Islands Region will be Küfre Bay. Then we will be anchoring in Uzun Liman (Long Port) for dinner and an overnight stay. |
| Day 4 | CLEOPATRA ISLAND - KARACASOGUT. The day starts by sailing to Sedir (Cleopatra) Island. This island resembles an open-air museum with its tiny beach and ancient ruins that you cannot find anywhere else. In the afternoon, we will anchor in Karacasogut. | Day 4 | TUZLA - LONGOZ - ENGLISH HARBOUR. The gulet will be anchoring in Tuzla Bay to enjoy a swimming break in the turquoise-blue waters. Breakfast will be served here. For lunch, our captain will cruise to Löngöz Bay; another place like paradise which is sheltered with huge pine forests. After lunch, you can enjoy a short walk in the forest and take a rest in Ali Baba's local shed-like cafe. Later we will cruise to English Port for dinner and an overnight stay. The name English Port comes from the time of 2nd World War when the ships of English Navy forces used to dock here. In this area, there are so many small and large bays which are suitable and sheltered enough to anchor for the boats. |
| Day 5 | LONGOZ - TUZLA BAY. Start your day by swimming in the morning hours. For lunch we will anchor at Longoz Bay, a paradise surrounded by pine forests. From here; we will sail towards Tuzla Bay, where you can swim in beautiful turquoise waters. Dinner and overnight stay will be in this wonderful bay. | Day 5 | AKBUK - CLEOPATRA ISLAND - KARACASOGUT. Early in the morning, we will cruise to Akbük and later on to Sedir (Cedrae) Island and tea time service will be given here. This unique island with its small beach and unbelievable clear water is like an open-air museum. You can see the city walls, the ruins from the Dorians' reign (later restored as a church); the amphitheatre with 1500 guest capacity and some vaulted historical buildings. You can walk around the wrecks of pillars with antique writings on them or the ancient stones decorated with reliefs. Cleopatra beach, located on this island has a very special kind of sand that can only be found in the deserts of Northern Africa. According to the myth, King Antonius brought the sand from Egypt by sea for Cleopatra. Later we will anchor at Karacasöğüt for dinner and an overnight stay. |
| Day 6 | KARGILI - KISEBUKU. In the early hours, we arrive at Kargili Bay (Molla İbrahim Bay), and after lunch on the boat, we will sail to Kisebuku (Alakışla Buku). Byzantine ruins on the coast can be visited. Dinner and overnight stay will be in this beautiful bay. | Day 6 | KARGILI - COKERTME. We will be in Kargılı Bay (Molla İbrahim Bay) early in the morning. After lunch and a swimming break in Kargılı, we will cruise to Çökertme. For dinner and an overnight stay, we will be anchoring at Çökertme Bay. |

| Day 1 | BODRUM. Boarding starts by 15:30. On the first day, our boat will remain anchored in Bodrum Port for dinner and an overnight stay. | Day 1 | BODRUM. Boarding the yacht in Bodrum Harbour. Welcome and information about the yacht and the tour programme. Dinner and overnight stay will be in the harbour of Bodrum. |
| Day 2 | PALAMUTBUKU - INCEBURUN. After breakfast, you will be informed about the cruise itinerary and the boat. Then we will start to cruise to Palamutbuku Bay early in the morning. We will anchor at Ince Burun after lunch and swimming breaks. We will stay in this lovely bay for dinner and an overnight stay. | Day 2 | BUYUK KIREMIT ADASI - GUMUSLUK. After breakfast, cruising to the island of Büyük Kiremit where the guests have a chance to relax. After lunch here, we will sail to the little naturl harbour of Gümüşlük (Ancient Myndos). Dinner and overnight stay will be made here. |
| Day 3 | AKTUR - BENCIK. After breakfast we will cruise to Aktur Bay. Then our first stop will be Bencik Bay which has a very narrow entrance but a unique view once you get inside. Bencik is located at the narrowest part of the peninsula that divides Hisaronu Gulf from the Gokova Gulf but it is located at Hisaronu side. In 550's B.C. the Cnidus people wanted to dig a tunnel in the narrowest land piece of the peninsula between the Hisaronu Gulf and the Gokova Gulf as a defense line against the Persians. | Day 3 | PANAYIR ISLAND - ALTINKUM - DIDIM. Cruising in the morning, we arrive Panayır Adası at the northen coast of the gulf. Breakfast will be served enroute. After the lunch, we will sail to Altinkum. We advise you to make an excursion to the ancient city of Didyma. |
| Day 4 | EMEL SAYIN BAY - ORHANIYE - SELIMIYE. After breakfast, we will anchor in Emel Sayın Bay and you can enjoy a swimming stop in this lovely bay. For lunch we will dock in Orhaniye. In Orhaniye Bay, you will see the unique scenery of a natural tidal formation called 'Kız Kumu' (Maiden's Beach). There are so many myths about this reddish sand-path going from the shore to the inner parts of the sea which is suitable for walking along. On a tiny island located in the bay, you can see the wrecks of an antique castle, a sign of an ancient city. Today, our final destination will be Selimiye for dinner and an overnight stay. | Day 4 | PRIENE - MILET. After breakfast in Altinkum, we alo advise you to make an excursion to the ancient cities of Priene, Millet. Overnight and dinner will be in one of the bays near Altinkum. |
| Day 5 | DIRSEBUKU - BOZBURUN. After anchoring in Dirsekbuku, we will go to Bozburun which is a small fishing town. This area was popular and suitable for sponge-diving but nowadays the people of the island are no more interested in sponge-diving as it is not financially beneficial and is dangerous. In recent years, sponge-diving has been replaced by gulet tourism and nowadays Bozburun Gulets take their place in this sector. | Day 5 | CAM ISLAND - KIYIKISLACIK (IASOS). After the breakfast, we will set sail (depending on the wind condition) to Cam Limani where we will have a lunch. In the afternoon we will cruise to the charming Kiyikislacik village. (Ancient Iasos), a little harbour surrounded by lovely fishrestaurants, and do not forget to make a trip to tje ruins of ancient Iasos. Dinner and overnight stay will be made here. |
| Day 6 | DATCA - KNIDOS (CNIDUS). We will cruise to Datca. Food and water will be supplied to the boat from Datca Harbor. We will cruise to Cnidus for dinner and an overnight stay. Cnidus was a developed city in science, art and architecture. Knidos was the home for Aphrodite's monument and in those times the city was famous for brothels and became popular for sailors and Arabic tradesmen. You may take a walk on the shore to see the ruins. | Day 6 | SALIH ISLAND - TURKBUKU. After breakfast, we will leave Iasos and cruise to Salih Island. After the lunch, we will cruise to Turkbuku for an overnight and dinner. |
| Day 7 | BLACK ISLAND - POYRAZ BAY - BODRUM. We will start to cruise early in the morning to Karaada (Black Island). Breakfast and a swimming break will be at Poyraz Bay which is located on the southern side of the island. This is such a nice bay with its turquoise-blue waters. We will dock in Bodrum Harbor for dinner and an overnight stay. | Day 7 | YALIKAVAK - CATAL ISLAND. Today we will cruise to Yalikavak, then stop in Catal Island to spend the last night. Dinner and overnight stay will be made here. |
