RHODES		SANTORINI - MYKONOS	
Day 1	<b>RHODES.</b> Boarding, dinner & overnight in Rhodes harbour.	Day 1	<b>SANTORINI.</b> Joining on board at 16.00. Aher our briefing take a 20 min walk up the steep donkey path to the old town of Thira or use the cable-car ( 5\$ p.p.}. Thira is the central town, full of boutiques, markets, taverna’s and coffee shops. This worldwide famous destination, honeymoon dream for couples around the world, reveals its secrets as our tour manager will show you the hidden gems of the island by offering an orientation walk. Later on enjoy a dinner at a local restaurant (optional} located on the cliffs, in order to watch the jaw-dropping sunset of Santorini. Take your BEST selfie, dream big and create memories that will be kept forever! Tonight we will be back on our boats at around 22:00 to mingle with your new friends and relax on your deck!
Day 2	<b>RHODES - BOZBURUN.</b> Today, we start early, and cruise to Bozburun in Turkey for customs formalities. We will stop in one of the many beautiful inlets on the way for breakfast and swimming. This is the perfect place for those who are looking for peace and tranquility. Bozburun is a small fishing village set among islands and inlets, quite the place for taking the nicest photos! It was once the sponge-fishing capital of Turkey but it is now regarded as one of the country’s boat-building centers. We have time to explore the port and village, buying the world-famous Turkish delight and enjoy the local Turkish culture. Visit the tea garden located under the Eucalyptus trees. Men can have a traditional shave and massage at the barber. Dinner and overnight in a bay at the Turkish coast.	Day 2	<b>SANTORINI - IOS.</b> Today we sail from Santorini to Ios and when we arrive, we head straight to the hottest beach on the island, called Mylopotas. The famous beach is full of young people, refreshing cocktails and hot sand. Brave enough to join the water sports! Get ready to explore hidden caves, swim at azure blue waters and experience Ios like never before! Aher our optional dinner, experience the famous night life of Ios with our bar crawl and get drunk with free shots and refreshing cocktails! Optional activity: Speed Boat safari & water sports.
Day 3	<b>SYMI - AGIA MARINA - AGIA NIKOLAOS.</b> Today, we cruise to Symi, one of the Dodecanese islands and a real gem, one of the most beautiful little islands in all of Greece. Please have your camera ready again for wonderful images of this small fairy-tale like island! We enjoy lots of swimming today in the many bays! Your dinner will be served on board, but if you wish to dine ashore by yourselves, please inform the captain in advance. All of the taverna’s on Symi are very tempting and the captain will understand your choice. Dinner and overnight.	Day 3	<b>IOS.</b> Aher Ios last night hangover take a refreshing dive to wake up or just chill at the wind curved beaches of Ios. Taste the famous traditional Greek cuisine by the sea, feel the vibe of the island and enjoy your free time. Later on the day, we will set our private BBQ at a secluded beach with lots of BOOZE, fun, free spirit, delicious local meat and get ready for the second round of pub crawl in Ios! Let’s do this! Activity: BBQ at a secluded beach (included}
Day 4	<b>SYMI - SANORMITIS.</b> We will cruise to Panormitis today, located in the southern part of Symi. On the way, we will stop for a swim and lunch in one of the beautiful bays around the island, at Nanou bay or one of the many other bays. You can visit the Monastery of the Archangel Michael Panormitis. This is a Greek Orthodox monastery built in the early 18th century, and still inhabited by monks. It is visited by people from all over the world, and many Greeks pay homage to St Michael of Panormitis each year. Dinner and overnight.	Day 4	<b>IOS - PAROS.</b> We depart from Ios and sail towards Paros. Aher your breakfast, get ready to explore the island with our Quad’s and experience first-hand the Cycladic scenery. Paros is famous for its water sports and especially wind surfing but also for its crazy night life! The island catches the warm winds and breezes of the sea, so if you fancy some adventure water sports this is the place to do so. Feel the breeze, get dazzled by the unparalleled beauty of Aegean Sea and stop for a swim at secluded bays. Later on walk around the old town or relax on white sandy beaches. At night get ready to feel the Cuba experience in Paros, enjoy shisha with your new friends and then head for clubbing till dawn! Optional activity: Quad Safari
Day 5	<b>SYMI - TILOS.</b> Today, we continue our cruising along the coast around Symi Island. Depending on the weather and sea conditions, we will continue to Tilos. Dinner and overnight.	Day 5	<b>PAROS.</b> Wake up smoothly and enjoy the Aegean archipelago of Paros. In the morning you have free time to charge your batteries and walk around the island. Take a refreshing dive at the golden waters of Paros Island or just chill with your friends. Your go! Your tour manager will offer you an orientation walk of Paroikia town and will inform you about the history of the island. Enjoy the Cycladic scenery, feel the breeze and later on get ready for our private beach party at a secluded bay in Paros, with loud music, lots of booze, optional karaoke and party until late! Are you ready for another pub crawl? We are happy to oblige! Activity: Private Beach Party (included} ***Weather dependent on Day 5 we will sail from Paros to Naxos and overnight there.

Day 6	<b>TILOS.</b> Tilos is surrounded by high and Rocky Mountains, steep coasts, beaches with transparent waters and caves. It has Medieval castles built or rebuilt by the Knights of St John, a Byzantine monastery, many small graphical churches and an in 1970 deserted village Mikro Chorio that is now declared a cultural monument. You may visit the Charkadio Cave full of paleontological discoveries like the famous dwarf elephant fossil bones. This is the place where the last elephants of Europe lived: the dwarf elephants appeared in the island 45,000 years ago and disappeared 4,000 years ago.	Day 6	<b>PAROS - MYKONOS.</b> We depart from Paros and sail towards Mykonos. In the morning we will explore the old town. Walk around the famous sugar-cube houses, feel part of little Venice, explore picturesque allies and say hi to the famous Pelican (mascot of the island}. Aher our optional lunch your tour manager will take you to Paradise Beach, the most famous beach of the island, full of young people and unique beach bars. Get ready to be body-painted and dance till dawn! Cavo Paradiso and Paradise club will host worldwide famous Dj’s and we will be our guests! This is Mykonos! Activity: Body paint Party (included}
Day 7	<b>TILOS - RHODES.</b> We will make our way back to the famous island of Rhodes. Free day to visit one of the best-preserved medieval towns in the world and a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage Site. Optional trips available today include rock climbing, jeep safari (self-driving or with professional driver}, scuba diving, hiking Filerimos, tour to Lindos with its cliffside acropolis, whitewashed houses and picturesque scenery. Dinner and overnight in Rhodes harbor.	Day 7	<b>MYKONOS.</b> Enjoy breakfast with friends on the vintage 30h wooden ship and if needed take a refreshing dive on a beach near by from your boat, while docked in the waters of Mykonos to wake up from the last night’s hangover! Today we have free time for shopping in the town of Mykonos and an optional lunch down town. At night, get ready for our private boat party event, with our famous DJ on board and unlimited refreshing cocktails and drinks! Later on join your pub crawl at Mykonos town, led by your tour manager! The night is ours! ** Weather dependent we might sail towards Rhnia, a secluded island 1 hour away from Mykonos and have our Private boat party there instead!** Activity: Private Boat Party ( included}
Day 8	<b>RHODES.</b> Enjoy an early delicious Mediterranean breakfast on board. Your cruise comes to an end. Disembarkation in Rhodes at 08:00. SKIATHOS		ZANTE (ZAKYNTHOS)	
Day 1	<b>SKIATHOS.</b> Embarkation to your gulet from Skiathos harbor. Skiathos is the most developed island in the Sporades. The island itself is quite mountainous and is covered with large trees giving it an unusually green appearance given the climate. It’s said that the island is home to 62 beaches which is pretty impressive given the island only has an area of 19 square miles. Overnight and the first dinner will be in harbor.	Day 1	<b>ZANTE.</b> Embarkation starts aher 15:30 at Zante harbor. Dinner and overnight will be here.
Day 2	<b>SKIATHOS - PANORMOS BAY (SKOPELOS ISLAND) .</b> Panormos means “every bay” as it’s protected from all sides. It’s fairly difficult to spot the entrance to the bay due to it being parallel with the bottom of Dhasis Island. The village within the bay is built on the site of an ancient town; some remains can still be seen on the beach.	Day 2	<b>ZANTE - KEFALONIA - POROS.</b> Depart from Zante and cruise towards Kefalonia, dropping anchor for the night in Poros, on the south-east coast.
Day 3	<b>PANORMOS BAY - PATITIRI (ALONNISOS ISLAND).</b> The largest town on the Alonnisos is Patitiri and is also home to the largest harbour on the island. Until 1965 is was a relatively minor harbour which served the old town of Palia, but an earthquake made the old town uninhabitable meaning the whole town moved down the hill. It’s a good spot to visit if the Meltimi is strong as the harbour offers good shelter.	Day 3	<b>POROS - ATOKOS.</b> Set sail for the tiny island of Atokos, a privately owned paradise inhabited only by goats. Anchor in an idyllic bay for the night.
Day 4	<b>PATITIRI - KYRA PANAGIA.</b> This small island is one of the many in the area which doesn’t support a permanent population apart from a few monks from a small monastery on the east coast. The island is part of the NMPANS nature reserve and is another place you might spot the Mediterranean Monk Seal.	Day 4	<b>ATOKOS - ITHACA - LYGIA.</b> o the unspoiled island of Ithaca, visiting its tiny capital of Vathy before cruising north to Lefkada to overnight in Lygia harbor.
Day 5	<b>KYRA PANAGIA - SKOPELOS ISLAND.</b> Skopelos is the largest of the four main islands in the Sporades. It’s slightly bigger than Mykonos and significantly bigger than Santorini. The nearest inhabited islands are Skiathos to the west and Alonissos to the east. Due to a large number of natural springs the island is home to large olive groves, plum trees, almond and orange trees. The island is also famous in ancient history for the quality of its wine.	Day 5	<b>LYGIA - PORTO SKALA.</b> TCruise south to Kefalonia to discover pretty Sami, one of the island’s prettiest villages, then on to Porto Skala and its fabulous beach.
Day 6	<b>SKOPELOS - KOUKOUNARIES.</b> Koukounaries lies at the southwest end of Skiathos and is a large sandy bay. A forest reserve can be found behind the beach, beyond that you can find a lagoon which is connected to the sea by a small river which follows out into the little harbour. It’s a beautiful little spot which is worth exploring in your dinghy (an outboard would come in handy here}.	Day 6	<b>PORTO SKALA - ARGOSTOLI - PESSADA.</b> Discover Argostoli, the island’s elegant capital, and then drop anchor for the night at Pessada on the south coast.
Day 7	<b>KOUKOUNARIES - SKIATHOS TOWN.</b> Skiathos town is the largest settlement on the island. Most of the town is made up of whitewashed houses and cobbled streets. In some areas of the town you can find some more ancient remains but the islands isn’t steeped with history compared to some of its other Greek counterparts. A bustling water front is home to a large number of restaurants and bars and on occasion you can also find open air concerts happening.	Day 7	<b>PESSADA - ZANTE.</b> Sail back towards Zante, spending time at tranquil Parous beach before heading for port in time to enjoy our farewell dinner.
Day 8	<b>SKIATHOS.</b> The guests will leave the boat with precious memories aher breakfast	Day 8	<b>ZANTE.</b> Disembarkation from Zante harbor aher breakfast.
